Directions: (From Highway 15)

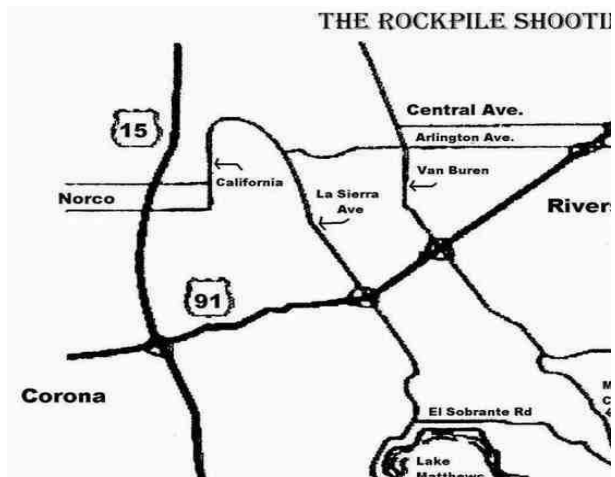
Take the southbound I 15 to Cajalco exit and turn left on Cajalco, or take the northbound I 15 to Cajalco and turn right on Cajalco.

Travel 7 miles to Lake Matthews Road and turn right.

Travel 5 miles to Santa Rosa Mine Road and turn right. (Note" Lake Matthews Road dead ends at Santa Rosa Mine Road).

Travel 3 miles to the single lane paved road and turn right (Note: Before you get to the paved road, you will notice traffic signs for dips in the road. After the third sign, slow down start looking for the paved road. At the junction of the paved road there are signs for Village Nurseries, and Maywood Gun Club).

Travel 2 miles on the paved road to where the pavement ends and proceed on the dirt road. There is a fork in the road at that point. Bear to the right and follow it to the large steel gate. Congratulations you are there!
